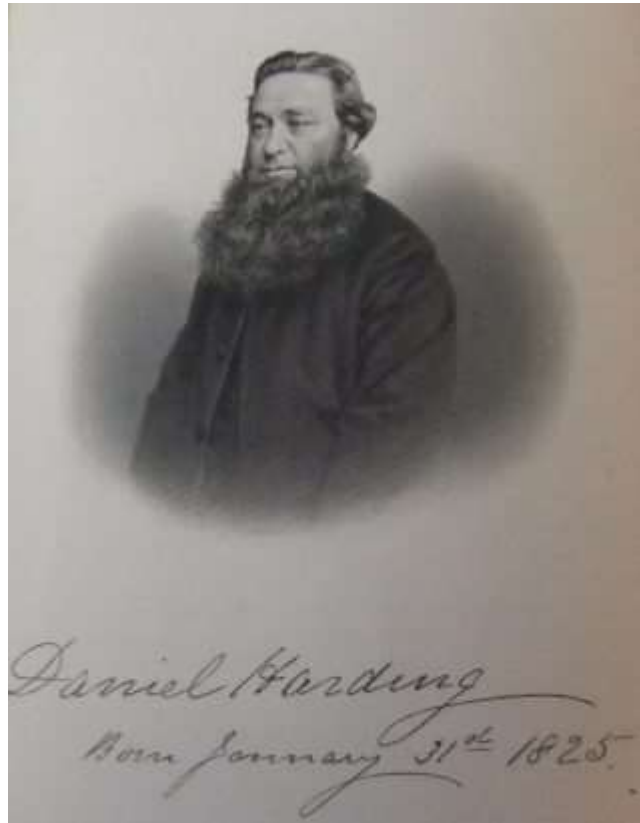


# Grave of the Month

Rev Daniel Harding  
Primitive Methodist  
Minister

1825-1905

Daniel was born in 1825 at Melksham, Wiltshire. Daniel attended the town school for a basic education. Daniel was a teetotaler from the age of 15.



Daniel was converted at the age of 20. Two years after becoming a local preacher he was recommended for itineracy.

Daniel married Alice Foss in 1855 at Luton. They had four children. Daniel was moved around different circuits, staying between one and four years in each. He first came to Newbury in 1870 then again in 1880, and lastly in 1891. He retired to Newbury as many Primitive Ministers did.

We are very lucky that Daniel's descendants contacted us and, having located his grave, returned to look after it.
